

2023 SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

The Adam Road School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges (as per School Board Operating Guidelines) for 2023. The schedule is broken into two sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that might be incurred throughout the school year.

SECTION I – CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay, has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the areas listed below. The actual costs per child are shown in the table beneath. While Contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments.

SECTION 2 – CHARGES

Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of **estimated charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities, etc. for 2023 has been included in the schedule below. Details on charges collected in previous years have helped determine our 2023 charges schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2023.

Please note: All charges for extra cost optional components will be requested at the time of the activity/ event occurring (i.e. "pay as you go").

The charges schedule includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g. incursions, excursions, etc.
- Specific learning activities only available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g. School of Instrumental Music program.
- Other activities available to groups of students, but conditional on a payment being made, e.g. school picnics, the graduation dinner dance, etc.

Refund Policy – Camps, Excursions & Incursions

Parents or guardians of students are given clear and comprehensive details of an excursion, incursion or camp, **and** their consent for the participation of their child is obtained **before** the event. Due to this, the school **will not** be refunding the fee charged if the child does not attend.

The only exceptions that will be considered, but are not guaranteed of a refund, are:

- Contracted a contagious disease doctor's certificate required
- Obvious inability to attend (e.g. broken leg and can't attend camp)
- Cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances.

Excursions/incursions and camps have fixed costs which are divided between the number of students attending the excursion/incursion or camp. The school is unable to refund part or all of the cost if a student happens to be away at the time, or is involved in a school suspension.

It is not possible to recoup the shortfall of money from the other students after the event.
